3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The most important duties of a Basic fashion and custom-made worker are:

Core task 1: Carries out technical pattern processes

- 1.1 Prepares the assignment with the client
- 1.2 Draws the pattern
- 1.3 Carries out fittings with the client or the model
- 1.4 Makes changes to the pattern in connection with the fitting

Core task 2: Carries out technical sewing processes

- 2.1 Prepares the working duties
- 2.2 Stitches the garment
- 2.3 Carries out final inspection of garment

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

De Basic fashion and custom-made clothes worker is employed in a ready-to-wear garments studio, the studio of an integrated ready-to-wear garments company or a clothing design and logistic company or in a studio for tailor-made apparel, where clothing is tailored to the individual client based on an in-house design or the design or wishes of the client, or in a repair company or alteration studio where garments are altered or repaired according to specific work orders.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) basic vocational programme, or a comparable level.
