3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The most important duties of a Logistics team leader are:

Core task 1: Receives and stores goods/products

- 1.1 Prepares reception and storage of goods/products
- 1.2 Receive and checks goods/products
- 1.3 Stores goods/products
- 1.4 Enters goods/products into the system

Core task 2: Taking orders

- 2.1 Does preparatory work for taking orders
- 2.2 Takes orders
- 2.3 Takes inventory of (part of) stock and/or the warehouse inventory
- 2.4 Completes the taking of orders

Core task 3: Send goods/products

- 3.1 Does preparatory work for shipping goods/products
- 3.2 Checks the goods/products to be shipped
- 3.3 Prepares goods/products for dispatch
- 3.4 Loads goods/products and concludes the preparation of goods/products for dispatch

Core task 4: Coordinates logistic tasks

- 4.1 Does preparatory work for the logistics team and distributes work
- 4.2 Monitors the implementation and progress of work of the logistics team
- 4.3 Monitors the equipment and materials and manages (part) of the warehouse
- 4.4 Supervises employees during work on the work-floor
- 4.5 Organises and/or advises on the stock management

A Logistics team leader carries out his tasks in a warehouse. These tasks can relate to reception, storage, collection and/or shipment preparation of goods/products. He can carry out his storage and supply management tasks in all sorts of branches.

The Logistics team leader can lead a team of logistic worker in small or large enterprises. Sometime he does this as a co-supervisor.

However the education and training for this profession on qualification level 3 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).
 In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.
 In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Average duration of the education/ training leading to the certificate

3 years (4800 study hours) (depending on previous education)

Entry requirements

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.

7. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dutch senior secondary VET is based on qualification files, that each contain one or more qualifications. The information included in part 3 and 4 is derived directly from the qualification file determined by the Minister of Education, Culture and Science. Optional subjects are linked to the qualification. The optional subjects have a total size of 15% of the course duration. The optional subjects completed by the student are listed on the certificate.
