- 2.1 Prepares the disassembly working duties
- 2.2 Disassembles scaffolding and support constructions
- 2.3 Inspects and sorts materials
- 2.4 Clears up the workplace

Core task 3: Tests and delivers scaffolding and support constructions

- 3.1 Delivers scaffolding and support constructions
- 3.2 Inspects scaffolding and support constructions
- 3.3 Repairs deficiencies and reports scaffolding and support constructions ready
- 3.4 Carries out safety procedures
- 3.5 Gives permission for scaffolding and support constructions to be used

Core task 4: Organises the daily working duties of the colleagues

- 4.1 Divides up the working duties and instructs colleagues
- 4.2 Monitors the quality and checks that instructions have been followed

All-round scaffolders work in the construction & and utility sector, civil engineering sector or industry. The works involve both the (dis)assembly of scaffolding for new construction, renovation/maintenance, and support constructions for concrete constructions.

International agreements The profession of All-round scaffolder is not regulated in the Netherlands. However the education and training for this profession on qualification level 3 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.
Legal basis Act on Vocational Education and Training (WEB), registered number of qualification (crebo): 93830 The education and training for this qualification is offered as of August 1, 2009.	

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).
 In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.
 In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.
