3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The most important duties of a Ground, road and waterway worker are:

Core task 1: Carries out road and waterway work

- 1.1 Sets up and maintains temporary traffic signs
- 1.2 Sets up and maintains work terrain
- 1.3 Makes cables and wiring safe
- 1.4 Digs up, fills up, raises and closes off the ground
- 1.5 Lays road foundations
- 1.6 Lays and/or repairs sewage pipe constructions and maintains trenches
- 1.7 Lays verges
- 1.8 Sets channels and drains, places road drains and fittings, lays road drainage
- 1.9 Repairs/ renews hard surfaces, road drains, drainage channels and fittings
- 1.10 Lays temporary hard surfaces
- 1.11 Places street furnishings, railings and barriers
- 1.12 Sets up work area at the agreed road

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The Ground, road and waterway worker works in the road and waterway sector. The Ground, road and waterway worker works for small, medium-sized or large companies. These companies are mainly active in wet and dry earth works, and in the laying and maintenance of roads and sewerage.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.
