- 2.3 Sets out components or auxiliary constructions
- 2.4 Installs temporary provisions
- 2.5 Adjusts the components and/or auxiliary constructions
- 2.6 Checks the final result
- 2.7 Clears out the work place

Core task 3: Assemble and/or compose

- 3.1 Arranges workplace
- 3.2 Sets out materials, tools and machines
- 3.3 Makes materials to size
- 3.4 Makes connections or anchoring
- 3.5 Places components
- 3.6 Checks the quality
- 3.7 Clears out the work place

Core task 4: Organises the daily working duties of the colleagues

- 3.1 Divides up the working duties and instructs colleagues
- 3.2 Monitors the quality and checks that instructions have been followed
- Discusses and comes to agreement with third parties 3.3
- Monitors the progress

Access to next level of education/professions

With the certificate of All-round carpenter building site and workshop, transfer is possible to a middle management or specialist course (qualification level 4).

The All-round carpenter building site and workshop can rise to various positions, such as foreman/operator or workshop manager. He can do the programme for qualification for Supervisor construction, infrastructure and specialised contracting.

International agreements

The profession of All-round carpenter building site and workshop is not regulated in the Netherlands. However the education and training for this profession on qualification level 3 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.

Legal basis

Act on Vocational Education and Training (WEB), registered number of qualification (crebo): 93301 The education and training for this qualification is offered as of August 1, 2008.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

Entry requirements

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.
