Access to next level of education/professions The Manager transport and logistics can after additional education and proven competences continue to grow to higher managerial positions in transport, expedition and warehousing. Horizontal through flows are also possible, for instance, to a distribution manager or warehouse manager. Besides, it often happens that the Manager transport and logistics grows towards entrepreneurship. The Manager transport and logistics can transfer to hbo. At this level he can follow the course Technical transportation and Logistics & economics.	International agreements The profession of Manager transport and logistics is not regulated in the Netherlands. However the education and training for this profession on qualification level 4 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the
