#### 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The most important duties of a Medical pedicurist are:

Core task 1: Carry out a basic pedicure treatment

- 1.1 Prepares treatment and receives the client
- 1.2 Makes treatment plan Carries out treatment
- 1.3 Carries out treatment
- 1.4 Provides advice and promotes the sale of products/services
- 1.5 Evaluates and finishes off treatment

Core task 2: Preparing for entrepreneurship

- 2.1 Prepares the launch of the company (sole proprietorship)
- 2.2 Prepares for business operations
- 2.3 Prepares for the promotion of the company

Core task 3: Carry out a medical pedicure treatment

- 3.1 Screens and examines the (potential) foot at risk
- 3.2 Gives treatment to (potential) risk foot
- 3.3 Applies pressure distribution techniques
- 3.4 Applies nail techniques

# 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The majority of the Medical pedicurists practises their profession as a sole proprietor. She has her own company or works ambulatory. The Medical pedicurist could be working in a group practice, healthcare institution, para medic centre, health care centre, diabetic centre or in a multidisciplinary foot team in a hospital. Some Medical pedicurists are paid employees.

# Name and status of the body awarding the certificate

The certificate issued on completion of the programme is signed by the examination board at the school where the pupil attended the programme.

# Name and status of the national/regional authority providing accreditation/recognition of the certificate Ministry of Education, Culture and Science

#### Level of the certificate (national or international)

Qualification level 4 of the Dutch VET qualification structure

Characteristics: non-job related skills such as tactical and strategic capacities. The professional bears his or her own responsibility, which is not only related to practical implementation in terms of monitoring and supervision, but also a more formal, organisational responsibility. The range of tasks also includes drafting new procedures.

#### Access to next level of education/professions

The Medical pedicurist could within the field of pedicure develop further concerning complementary and specialist treatments and by working in a multidisciplinary foot team in a hospital. Further promotion is possible to positions such as: educational instructor, manager, assessor as well as commercial positions with companies for foot care products and foot care materials. She could also become an independent entrepreneur. A Medical pedicurist could with additional education be transferred to a Podotherapist, for instance. She must be transferred to higher vocational educations. She could also be transferred to other para medic courses, such as skin therapy and physiotherapy.

#### International agreements

The profession of Medical pedicurist is not regulated in the Netherlands. However the education and training for this profession on qualification level 4 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.

#### Legal basis

Act on Vocational Education and Training (WEB), registered number of qualification (crebo): 25405 The education and training for this qualification is offered as of August 1, 2015.

#### 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

#### **Entry requirements**

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.

Dutch senior secondary VET is based on qualification files, that each contain one or more qualifications. The information included in part 3 and 4 is derived directly from the qualification file determined by the Minister of Education, Culture and Science. Optional subjects are linked to the qualification. The optional subjects have a total size of 15% of the course duration. The optional subjects completed by the student are listed on the certificate.
