- 3.4 Makes conservation plans

Core task 4: Supervises restorations and maintenance

- 4.1 Supervises restorations and maintenance activities
- 4.2 Monitors time and cost of the restoration work
- 4.3 Takes restoration measurements
- 4.4 Performs quality control and monitors restoration activities

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

A Supervisor restoration can work at architectural and consultation firms, in the construction/infrastructure sector, monument preservation institutions and construction companies. He is involved in designing, carrying out and maintaining projects. Depending on the organisation he works for, he will be involved in multiple aspects or carry out a specialised task.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

Entry requirements

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.
