4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE
<p>The Draughtsman measuring is employed by insulation companies. Insulation companies carry out insulation working duties on technical installations in mostly market segments in the industry and construction industry. Installations in the industry are process oriented; installations in the construction industry are comfort oriented. The industry includes sectors such as chemistry and petro chemistry, power plants, food industry and shipping industry. Construction industry includes offices, swimming pools, hospitals and so forth. Insulation companies offer thermic insulation, acoustic insulation and fire resistant insulation. Objects such as, for instance, process lines, cooling pipes, heat pipes, water pipes, kettles and devices are insulated.</p>

Access to next level of education/professions Within the working area work planning there are few obvious career prospects which can be obtained by means of training or experience. The Draughtsman measuring can: - continue to grow to a position of developer and/or project leader - continue to grow and broaden in the field of work planning.	International agreements The profession of Draughtsman measuring is not regulated in the Netherlands. However the education and training for this profession on qualification level 3 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE	
<p>Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).</p> <p>In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.</p> <p>In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.</p>	
Average duration of the education/ training leading to the certificate	3 years (4800 study hours) (depending on previous education)
Entry requirements The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.
