3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The most important duties of a Doctor's assistant are:

Core task 1: Takes care of intake, information and advice

- 1.1 Speaks with the care recipient and channels the care demand
- 1.2 Gives information and advice

Core task 2: Contributes to medical care

- 2.1 Prepares the surgery, equipment and tools for the treatment
- 2.2 Assists the practitioner with the medical treatment
- 2.3 Performs actions in the framework of individual health care
- 2.4 Supports and informs the care recipient

Core task 3: Performs organization- and profession-related duties

- 3.1 Participates in staff training and professionalization of the profession
- 3.2 Works on the improvement and assurance of quality care
- 3.3 Consults about the work
- 3.4 Performs management duties
- 3.5 Performs administrative duties

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The Doctor's assistant can work in various types of organizations, such as the (solo and group) general practice, weekend/evening surgeries, outpatients' clinic, social health care, youth health care, blood transfusion services, laboratory and medical services.

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5. OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE	
<p>Qualification level 4 of the Dutch VET qualification structure</p> <p>Characteristics: non-job related skills such as tactical and strategic capacities. The professional bears his or her own responsibility, which is not only related to practical implementation in terms of monitoring and supervision, but also a more formal, organisational responsibility. <p>Access to next level of education/professions</p> <p>This programme gives access to higher professional education (hbo), for example the Practice nurse, Practice manager or Manager programmes</p> <p>The research report 'The only way out is together' (NVDA, 2003) mentions two possible specializations for a vertical career step. These are the care-specific specialization and the specialization in organization and management (at hbo level).</p>	<p>International agreements</p> <p>The profession of Doctor's assistant is not regulated in the Netherlands. However the education and training for this profession on qualification level 4 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.</p>
<p>Legal basis</p> <p>Act on Vocational Education and Training (WEB), registered number of qualification (crebo): 91310</p> <p>The education and training for this qualification is offered as of August 1, 2008.</p>	

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE	
<p>Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).</p> <p>In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.</p> <p>In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.</p>	
<p>Average duration of the education/ training leading to the certificate</p>	<p>3 year(s) (4800 study hours) (depending on previous education)</p>
<p>Entry requirements</p> <p>The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.</p>
