3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The most important duties of a Car spray painter are:

Core task 1: Prepares surfaces

- 1.1 Prepares and monitors the preparatory treatment of sub-surfaces
- 1.2 Furnishes the workplace for the preparatory treatment of sub-surfaces
- 1.3 Prepares surface for application of primers
- 1.4 Processes primers
- 1.5 Prepares object for finishing (topcoat)
- 1.6 Checks the pre-treated sub-surface and finalises the job

Core task 2: Sprays topcoat materials

- 2.1 Prepares and monitors the spraying of topcoat materials
- 2.2 Furnishes the workplace for the spraying of topcoat materials
- 2.3 Processes finishing materials (topcoat)
- 2.4 Checks the sprayed object and finalises the job

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The Car spray painter works in the bodybuilding industry in the preparation and spray painting department. He prepares surfaces, spray paint topcoat materials and carries out work according to specified procedures. He carries out this work at a workshop.

education (as car spray paint teacher).

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.
