3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The most important duties of a Care provider disability care are:

- 1.2 Supports the client in their personal care
- 1.3 Supports the client in accommodation and household duties
- 1.4 Supports the client in their daily business
- 1.5 Responds to unforeseen crisis situations
- 1.6 Coordinates the work
- 1.7 Evaluates the support offered

Core task 2: Work on quality and expertise

- 2.1 Works on one's own expertise
- 2.2 Works at the improvement and monitoring of the quality care

Core task 3: Offer care and support in disability care

- 3.1 Supports and motivates a group of clients in activities
- 3.2 Supports, informs and advises the client and close relatives in maintaining and encouraging the development
- 3.3 Carries out technical nursing treatments
- 3.4 Coaches new colleagues apprentices and/or volunteers

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The Care provider disability care offers care and support to people of any age with mental, physical, sensorial or multiple disabilities. In this she attends to various types of problems:

- Problems caused by a disorder or disease
- Problems which have appeared during the course of life, enhanced by disability or disease.
- Problems caused by the healthcare system

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.
