3. Profile of skills and competences

The most important duties of a Car damage repair mechanic level 3 are:

- 1.2 Determines and monitors how work assignment is carried out
- 1.3 Prepares working duties
- 1.4 Aligns bodywork parts
- 1.5 Repairs bodywork parts
- 1.6 Maintains workplace, tools and apparatus

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The bodywork sector consists of companies (or parts thereof) that do repairs on luxury passenger cars, motor bikes, recreational vehicles (caravans, campers) and/or company vehicles. Or, companies in the field of new and old bodyworks. The Car damage repair mechanic level 3 works mainly in companies that are specialized in damage repair of luxury and company vehicles.

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.
