- 1.8 Assesses proposals and supply contracts and drafts terms of delivery
- 1.9 Signals complaints and points for improvement and processes these
- 1.10 Coordinates with management

Core task 2: Leads and carries out management tasks

- 2.1 Devises an operational plan
- 2.2 Plans and assigns tasks
- 2.3 Budgets finances
- 2.4 Monitors finances
- 2.5 Manages and provides guidance to (apprentice) employees
- 2.6 Conducts formal internal meetings

#### 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

A Facility services manager can be employed by facility service provider or work in facility service of an organisation (either profit or non-profit). These organisations can include: (semi-) governmental institutions, health institutions, educational institutions, business service providers and manufacturing companies. # 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl).

In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week.

In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.

### **Entry requirements**

The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.
