## 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The most important duties of a Supervisor protection and finishing are:

- determining the policy strategy of the company;
- employing marketing techniques;
- acquisition;
- producing pre- and postcalculations;
- advising on colours, products and systems;
- drawing up colour and interior design recommendations;
- planning, organising and applying paint systems (or having them applied) to various surfaces according to industrial working methods;
- planning the routing and developing and managing processes for applying paint systems;
- issuing technical information about products and systems;
- drawing up technical recommendations and reports in the field of product and system development and applications;
- carrying out and interpreting colour measurements;
- designing lettering and decorative painting and undertaking (or ordering) this work;
- restoring paint work;
- capacity to apply protection and finishing techniques;
- carrying out high-quality paint work of craftsman standard;
- responsibility for internal and external communication;
- independent business operation, including administration;
- monitoring progress of work to be undertaken, taking account of the environment, health and safety at work legislation and quality assurance;
- managing a business and employee management;
- management skills in respect of preparation, planning, logistics and implementation of work.

## 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

Calculator, planner, project manager operations, colour technologist, quality controller.  
Depending on specialisation: restoration painter, decoration and interior design consultant, technical paint consultant.

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<p><b>Access to next level of education/professions</b> With a diploma at qualification level 4, transfer is possible to higher professional education.</p>	<p><b>International agreements</b> The profession of Supervisor protection and finishing is not regulated in the Netherlands. However the education and training for this profession on qualification level 4 is regulated under the European directive 2005/36/EC, amended by directive 2013/55/EU. The regulated education and training gives access to regulated professions at the level of a diploma according to article 11 of this directive.</p>

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

<p>Senior secondary vocational education features two learning pathways: the school-based pathway (bol) and the training on the job pathway (bbl). In the school-based pathway, the majority of the course consists of theory at school. The extent of the practical component (vocational practice) is between 20% and 60%. In the training on the job pathway, the extent of vocational practice is at least 60% of the course. The participant works four days a week in a training company, and attends school for theory subjects just one day a week. In principle it is possible to follow both learning pathways, but which pathway is offered will depend on the individual educational institution.</p>

<p><b>Entry requirements</b> The certificate preparatory vocational secondary education (vmbo) advanced vocational programme, combined programme, or theoretical programme, or a comparable level.</p>
